Children in EYFS and KS1 are invited to create/decorate Easter Bonnets to be used as part of the assembly which will be held on Friday 31st March.

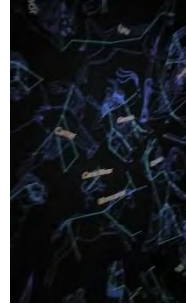
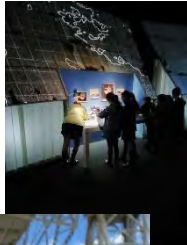
Children in KS2 are invited to decorate an egg in the theme of 'inspirational people'. Eggs will be displayed during the coffee morning on Friday 31st March.
