






Many of our Year Six pupils have taken part in their residential this week at Waddow Hall in Clitheroe.

In Science, this week, Year 4 have been learning about different types of teeth, how to look after them and what happens to our teeth when we don't. We planned an investigation to find out how eggshells react to different liquids as tooth enamel and an eggshell are made from similar materials and they both have similar functions. We covered part of the eggshell with toothpaste and placed them in a cup of tea, cola, vinegar, milk and water. Each day, we have observed what has happened to the eggshells. Our investigation will finish on Monday.










