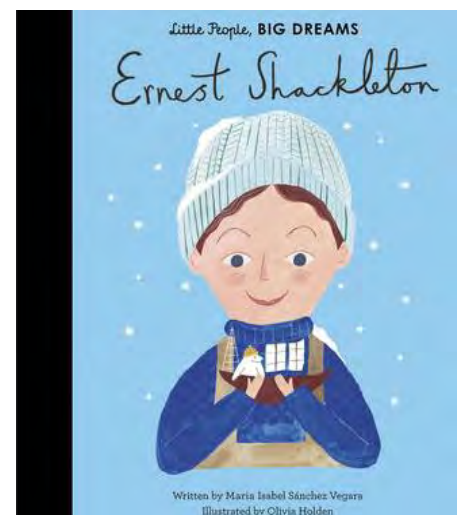
4S have been thinking about our school values. This week, our class has explored our 'Achieve' value.

Amber said, "Everyone can achieve if they put their mind to it."





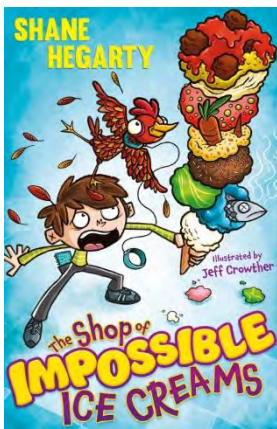
# Book Corner

*Limpet's not sure about this. He likes a nice, safe life. His favourite ice-cream flavour is vanilla.*

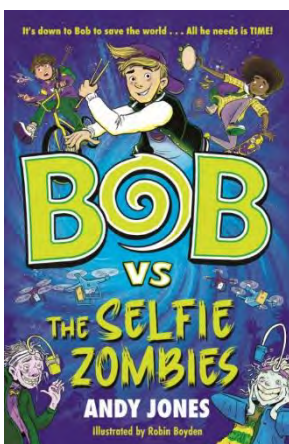
