We are very proud of all of the students who are involved in this program. They are making a real difference, and setting themselves up for success in the future.

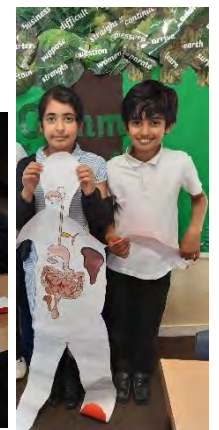
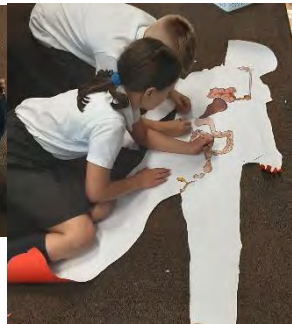
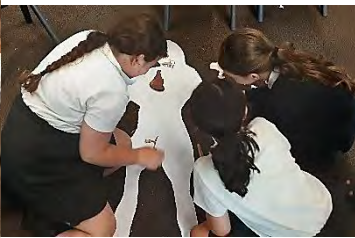
