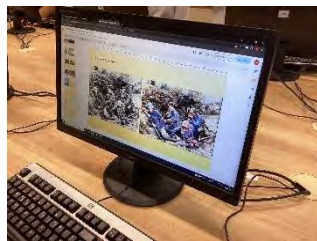
On Tuesday, Tameside Reporter came to Aldwyn to interview our children about their learning in Computing.

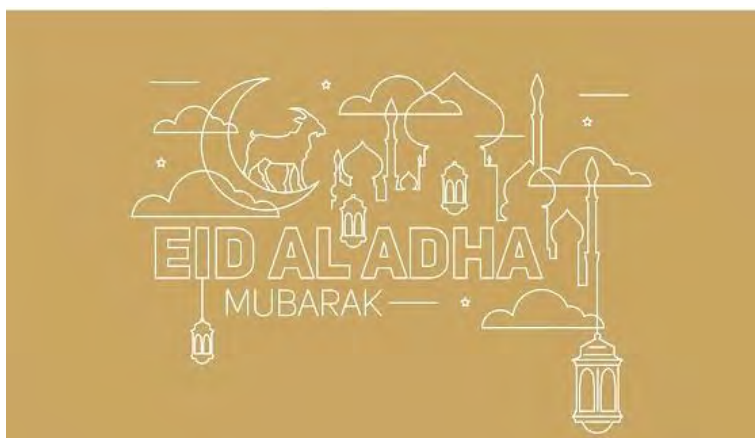
