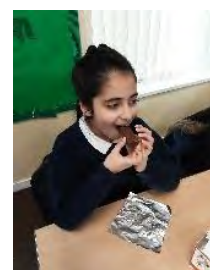
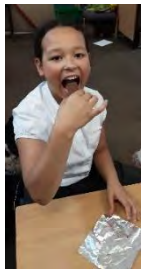


What a treat it was for us to share in the learning of the Ancient Egyptians with Year 3 during their brilliant and informative assembly on Wednesday. Well done Year 3!



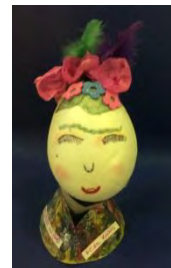
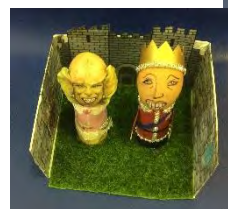

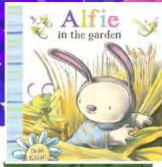
