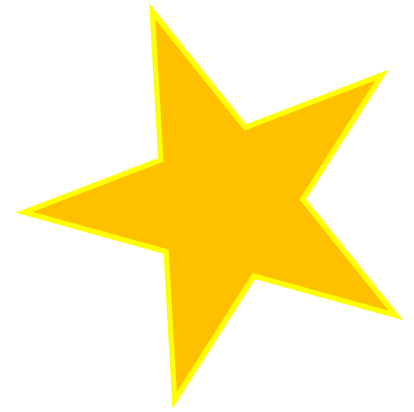
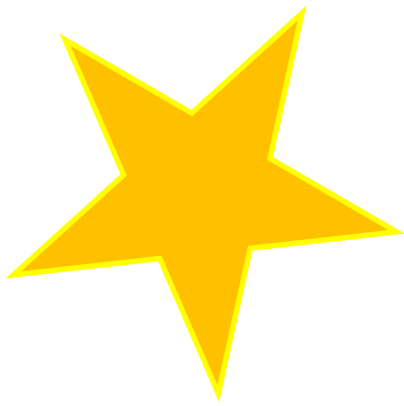
European Day of Languages

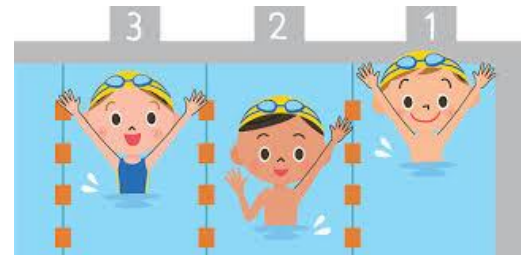
