# We would like to take this opportunity to remind parents of our school uniform expectations ahead of any purchases ready for the return to school in the new year.

Below are the guidelines for Aldwyn school uniform:

#### Winter Uniform

- Grey skirt, pinafore, trousers or shorts
- White blouse, shirt or polo shirt (school logo optional)
- Navy blue sweatshirt or cardigan (school logo optional)
- Black shoes NOT TRAINERS OR CONVERSE

#### **Summer Uniform**

Same as above, but:

- Blue and white dresses may be worn
- Sandals which fasten onto the foot may be worn

#### Indoor PE Kit

- White T-shirt (plain)
- Black shorts
- Pumps or trainers with non-marking sole for indoor games
- Bare feet for gymnastics

#### **Outdoor PE Kit**

- White T-shirt (plain)
- Black shorts
- Trainers

A plain, dark tracksuit (or jogging bottoms and sweatshirt) may be worn in colder months.

#### For all PE lessons

- Earrings must be taken out. (Children who cannot remove their studs must bring in tape e.g. Micropore)
- Watches must be removed (No other jewellery is permitted in school).
- Long hair must be tied back.

#### **For Swimming**

- Full swimsuit
- Trunks (or shorts above knee length)
- Swimming cap (for long hair)

#### **After School Sports Clubs**

• Children attending after school sports clubs must wear the school PE kit. Additional clothing may be suggested for certain clubs e.g. football boots or shin pads.


