



Well done Year 1 - Children have successfully logged into Google Cloud and connected to Google Classroom. They are starting a journey into the world of Digital Skills, important skills they will use for the rest of their lives. Once logged in, they can collect work from Google Classroom and start their project named "Animals Of The World". This improves their typing skills and the ability to find and insert the correct pictures into a Google Slide show.

Year 4 has started to record their podcasts. Children have researched a subject of their choice, written a script and produced an "autocue" that they can read from. They used Google Gemini AI to help them do some of the research and create a resource sheet. From this, they wrote their script. We are using professional online podcast creation software to produce the podcast and add royalty-free music and sound effects.



Last Friday, Aldwyn joined in with the biggest Girls football event, Let Girls Play day! Our game changers Ava and Darcie in year 6 shared their Football journey to inspire the children and show the pathways in which the children can take to get into football outside of school. To encourage girls to play and have a go our KS2 children had an inter school competition. All the girls were invited to play and have friendly games. In school we had a knock-out competition with a prize for the winning team. The year 6 mini whistlers helped referee and coordinate the event. The girls had a great time and really enjoyed the event!

















This week, Year 4 visited Droylsden Library. Lisa the librarian reminded us about all the fantastic things that we can do when we visit the library. She showed us how to access Borrowbox. Borrowbox is an eBook and eAudiobook service where you can download books, comics, magazines and newspapers to read or listen to on a home computer or mobile device. 
