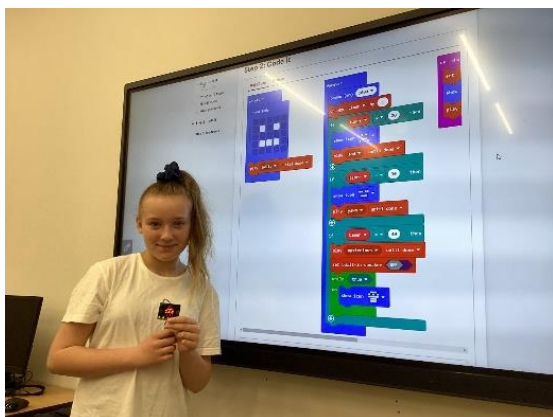
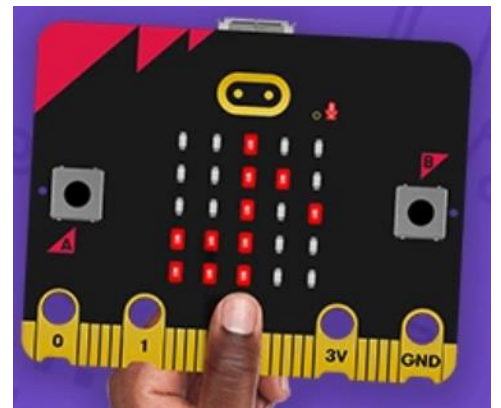

This week, in Year 4 we have been writing our Charlie and the Chocolate Factory settings. We have used ambitious and adventurous language, fronted adverbials, prepositional phrases, figurative language and our senses to make our descriptions come to life to the reader. We have enjoyed using our creative imaginations to create our settings.



Electronic pets were invented in Japan in the 1990s and soon became a popular toy all over the world. So, we thought it might be a good idea for year 6 to reinvent them using a BBC Micro:bit microcontroller. A creature is shown on a simple display. You have to look after it, interacting with it by pressing buttons and playing simple games. If you ignore it and don't feed or clean it, it will get sad, misbehave, or become unwell. The code makes use of all sorts of things like LOOPS, VARIABLES, LOGIC, TIMERS, INPUT, PROCESS and OUTPUT. The children really liked this project and enjoyed looking after their electronic pets.





Last Thursday Aldwyn went to Droylsden Academy to play Greenside for the next fixture of the cup matches. Aldwyn had a strong start leading with 1 goal, an unfortunate hand ball lead to Greenside scoring and making it 1 all at half time. 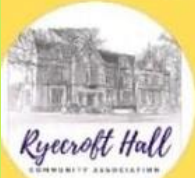
