This term in RE, Year Two have been learning about what it means to belong to a faith community. We have learned that Christians get their children baptized. Our Year Two children have been using Code.org, which is a fantastic way to introduce children to coding. The first series of lessons gently introduces the concepts of problem solving then as the lessons move on the challenges get harder and harder. Children are encouraged to break down the problem into smaller steps and test each step before moving on, something called decomposition. Breaking down a complex problem or system into smaller parts that are more manageable and easier to understand is a skill that most people use in everyday life. As children finished the course they received a coding certificate.




