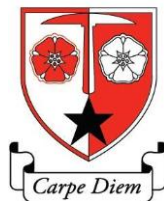

Explore – Exploring the internet

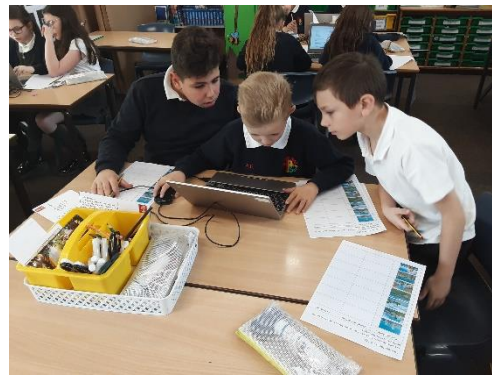
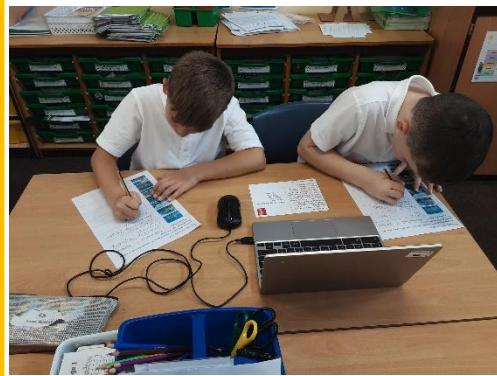
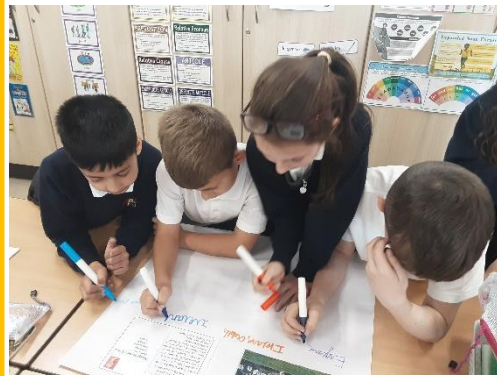

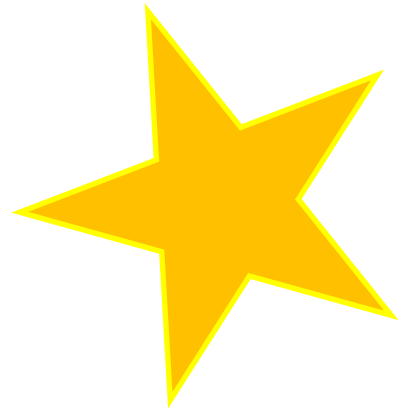
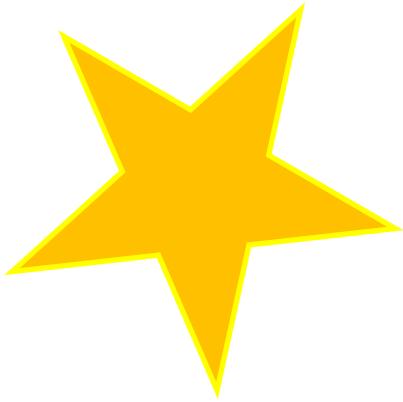
## Computer Club
