

In Y4 our new Science topic is 'States of Matter', 4M split into three groups then had instructions of how the particles in that state behave. They demonstrated their 'performance' to the rest of the class and they had to guess whether they were a solid, liquid or a gas. We found that the particles are tightly packed in a solid, they move a little close to each other in a liquid and they can move around freely in a gas.





The children in Reception collected some frogspawn from the pond before the holidays and have been watching it closely as it has developed into tadpoles.

This week they were very excited to see that one of the tadpoles has become a froglet and was sitting on the rock. On Thursday they were able to release 'Fred' into the pond area to continue to grow and develop now it is a frog.



This term, Year 4 are learning about rivers. This week, we used the atlases to locate the 10 longest rivers in the world.

Did you know, the longest river in the world is the Nile, stretching approximately 6650 kilometres (4,132 miles). The river runs through northern Africa across 10 countries, starting from Uganda and ending in Egypt into the Mediterranean Sea














We are aware of cases of headlice across school. Please could you thoroughly check your child's hair tonight. If you see any signs of headlice, please treat your child's hair.

Our team won their group stage and their quarter final. They progressed to the semi-final, but unfortunately lost out to a late goal.


