They learnt about how animals transport seeds into different areas, with a fantastic experiment in the woods using Rich Tea biscuits. We even saw a cheeky squirrel running off with one of our biscuits!
The trip was rounded off with some free time in the adventure playground where they built dens and had a fantastic time climbing, swinging and crawling through tunnels. Several children in 3F also created a musical performance in the woodland music area. Children in Year two have been learning about sequencing commands to make an online BeeBot move around a maze. They were given different challenges and had to modify their code and debug it to get the BeeBot to move to the correct place on the mat. Children completed some difficult tasks and managed to string together as many as 20 different commands.


Children in Year 5 have been making one-minute videos on Canva. They could choose any subject they wanted and then find the correct video to fit their story. They had to make sure that each section was not too long and then add transitions between each section and make sure they all flowed smoothly. Finally, children had to choose a piece of suitable music to bring their video to life.
