They had a fantastic time, taking part in a workshop about parts of a plant and seed dispersal, and then planting their own lettuce in the garden area.

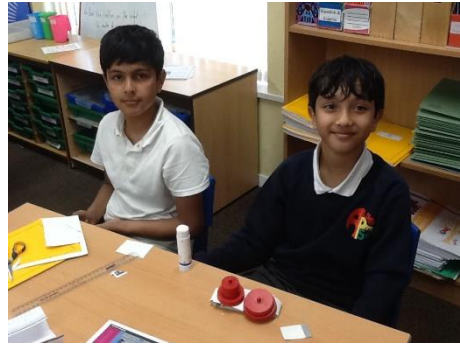

As usual all the children were fantastic ambassadors for Aldwyn; several members of the public stopped Mrs. Clark to offer praise to our children! A good time was had by all!





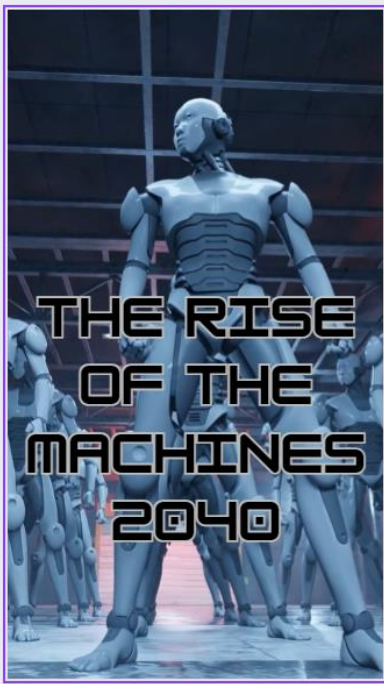
This week Year 5 have been learning all about bridge structures in DT. The children made their own bridge structures and then tested them using a series of different weights. The children loved testing out their bridges and were very proud of how much they could hold.

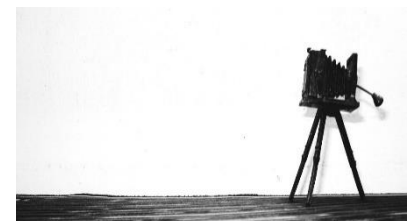
