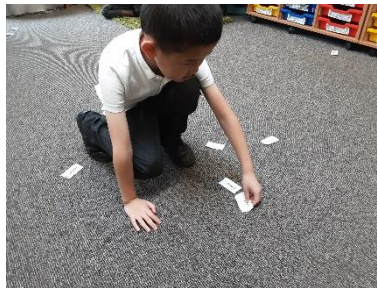

Well done to 4S who are this week's attendance champions with 96%

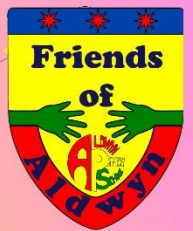

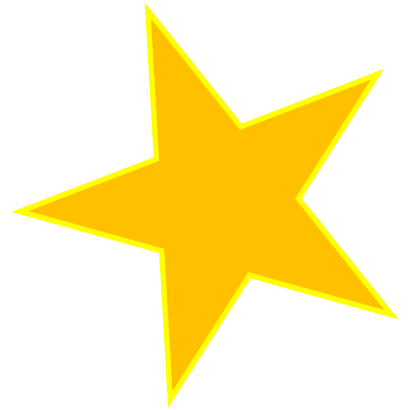
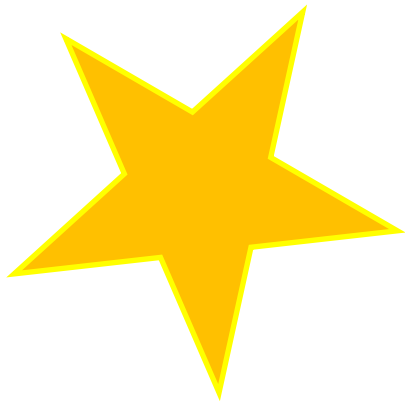
