

Over the next few weeks Year 4 will be learning about how digital pictures can be edited to make them look completely different. Children will explore when they need to rotate and crop an image as well as how to use an image editor to make these changes. Learners will then discuss image composition and children will learn how to use the clone tools to remove or add different objects. They will learn that many manual editing techniques have now been replaced with AI image editors and children will be able to compare the two ways of editing images.



This term, Year Three have been learning about structures in their Design Technology lessons with the main focus on castles. This week 30 used a wide range of materials to create their own castles. Whilst designing and constructing their castles they needed to consider different features of castles and how they could incorporate them into their designs. The children used creative thinking to create drawbridges, turrets, towers, windows and doors for their castles. Many also included battlements on their castles.

This week we have been able to meet our teachers for next year and spend some time in our new class. We have enjoyed the opportunity to welcome our families into school to share with you information about life in the next year group and to meet our new families who will join with us in September.





Year 6 have been learning all about AI and this series of structured lessons combine hands-on experience with discussions about AI's potential and limitations. The aim of the lessons, which will take place over the next few weeks, is to show how AI tools can be used to enhance learning and how AI can help children produce all types of content from graphics to AI generated music.

They begin with an overview of AI and machine learning, explaining how computers can be trained to perform tasks typically done by humans. Year 6 will then have access to Google Teachable Machine, which will enable them to generate their own data sets and train their own AI machine.

Year Four have been learning about digestion in science. Class 4M have made their very own stomachs and intestine with tights and looked at how crackers, acid and saliva travelled through our very makeshift digestive system.

They even made bottoms for the food to come out of!!

Ted from 2H took part in the Race for Life. He ran 5k with his Dad and managed to raise £470 for charity.


Richie from 3F also took part in the 5k Race for Life.
