- If your child is slightly under the weather, still send them into school – children often start feeling better as the day goes on and they get busy, and if the school is worried, we will call you.

Aldwyn School Meals

Mrs. Phillips, our school cook, delivers a wide menu to the children which she cooks on site each day with many of the items homemade. As term began in September, we launched a new menu which the children are enjoying. School dinners are £3.48 per day and are paid for at the moment through ParentPay.

All children in Reception, Year One and Year Two are entitled to a free school meal through the Universal free school meal offer. Your child may be entitled to benefits related free school meals. Please complete the attached form so that we can check eligibility. We would urge all parents to do this as it will enable you to access other benefits for your child including supermarket vouchers for school holiday meals, and whilst you may not be currently eligible, should your circumstances change in the future the system will recognise the change and alert school to a change in eligibility.
