Our focus for this half term's value is 'Achieve'. Mrs Oakes' class will be looking at the author Astrid Lindgren who wrote the stories about Pippi Longstocking, and Miss Fells class will be reading about Malala Yousafzai, the young activist and campaigner. Both these people have made huge achievements throughout their lives through hard work and determination.

English

In English, we will be writing setting and character descriptions then moving on to write a set of instructions. We will be using the rhymes from George's Marvellous Medicine to write our own poems.

Our guided reading will focus on a range of decoding and questions which will help us to understand a range of different texts. We will use the Reading Gem questions to predict, summarise, retrieve, define, sequence, explore, compare and relate our reading text.

We will be recapping phonics sounds and spellings from Year 2 as well as learning new spelling patterns.




Maths

In maths, over the next few weeks, we will learn:

- Understand and use Place Value
- Representing numbers to 1000
- Comparing and ordering numbers
- Partitioning numbers to 1000
- Counting in steps of 25, 50 and 100
- Addition
- Subtraction
- Estimating
- Problem solving

<u>Science</u>

In our science work, we will be learning about the different food groups and the nutrition that they provide us. We will understand the impact the different food groups have on the human body, then we will design our own healthy menus.



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Research

Geography - Where does our food come from?

This half term, we will be exploring the continents and the different biomes to find out where different foods come from around the world, and how this can impact on our environment.

Design Technology



In Design and Technology, we will be looking at foods that are in season. The children will the be designing and creating different recipes using fruit and vegetables that are in season. The fun part is that they will get a chance to taste the different foods!

Music

This half term, the children will be listening to, appraising and improvising music based on the song 'Let your Spirit Fly.'

PE

In PE, we will be looking at different the skills involved in basketball. The children will work on their own, in pairs and small groups to develop their knowledge and understanding of invasion games.



Our PE lesson is on a Wednesday, please remember to have a school PE kit (plain white T-shirt and plain black shorts) in school at all times.

<u>Art</u>



We will be looking at the drawings and illustrations of Quentin Blake. Using pen, pencil and watercolours we will have a go at drawing in Blake's style.

Quentin Blake illustrated many of Roald Dahls stories, and we will be looking out for these while reading George's Marvellous Medicine.

French

We will start learning French this half term! Our topic is 'Greetings' and we will learn new vocabulary for greeting different people at different times of the day or night. We will practising using these in conversations to build up our confidence.

We will learn some vocabulary associated with different foods, and have a go at asking for different things in a shop role play situation.

PSHE

The unit for this term is: 'Being Me in My World.' We will underestand how to value ourselves and others. We will recognise how it feels to be happy, sad or scared and identify if others are feeling these emotions. We will understand that our behaviour brings rewards / consequences.



Computing

In our computing work with Mr Goodier, we will be practising our word processing skills, then learning to click and drag images into a document and change how they look. This will be themed around George's Marvellous Medicine.

Homework

A piece of English and Maths will usually be given every Friday, in a homework folder. This should be returned by the following Wednesday. In addition, there will be a times tables and spelling to learn for a 'test' on the following Friday. Please support your child by listening to them read as often as possible.

We are very pleased to have Mrs Charles working in Mrs Oakes class until February 2025. Mrs Charles is doing her teacher training with us and will also work in year 5 later in the school year.
