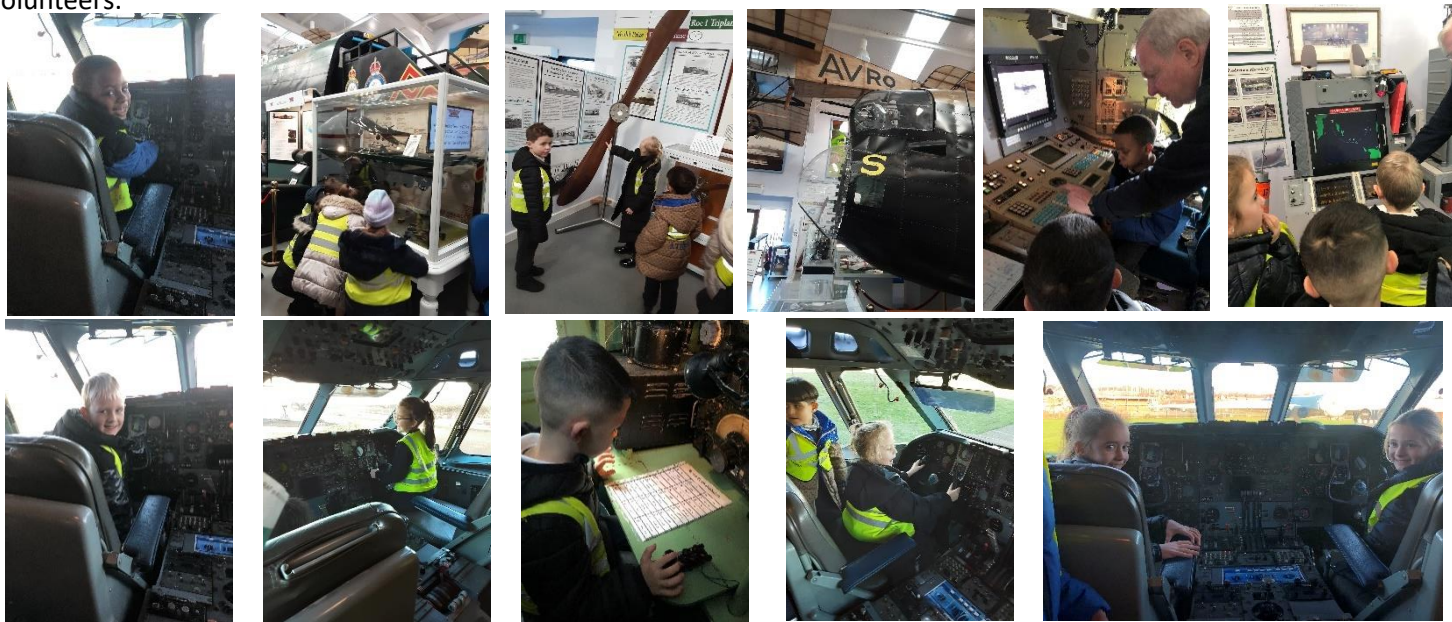

We have had a fantastic week of investigations, experiments and explorations during Science Week. Thank you for supporting our science evening on Wednesday, it was wonderful to see our families enjoying the range of science topics together. Thank you to Mrs Parkes for organising the evening.

On Thursday 2MK had a visit to the Avro Heritage Museum in Stockport. The children have learnt about the history of flight, and on this visit they had the opportunity to learn about how important Avro was for almost 100 years, so close to home! The children went into different cockpits of Avro aircraft, the Nimrod, the Vulcan and a Lancaster Bomber and saw how the instruments have changed over time. They learnt how to hunt for submarines, who A.V. Roe was and why he was so important in British aviation history and even imagined being the Queen in a VC10, where they were shown around by Richard a volunteer, who used to actually be a VC10 pilot for the Queen!! As always, the children did us proud and their superb behaviour was commented on by many of the Museum volunteers.



As part of their Geography and Science work about The Seasons, Year One went outside to explore.

The children went outdoors to look for signs of Winter. They explored the effect that frost had had on the grass and soil and observed the tiny fragments of frost that had formed on the wooden planters.

The children made Winter journey sticks to record some of the things that they discovered.

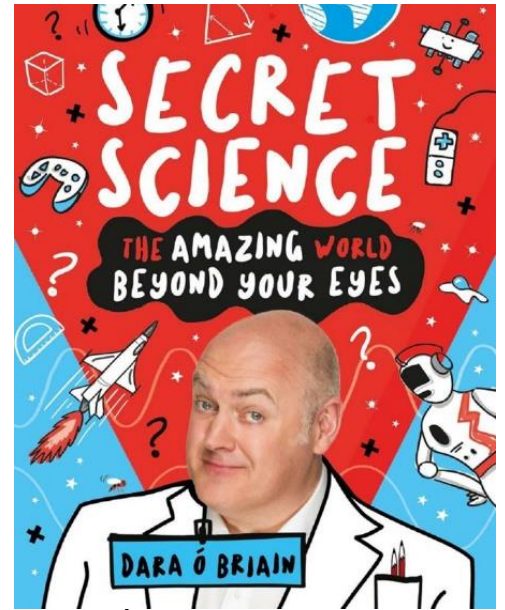
