Then we planned a sequence to show how we would write the steps as instructions, using time connectives and imperative verbs.



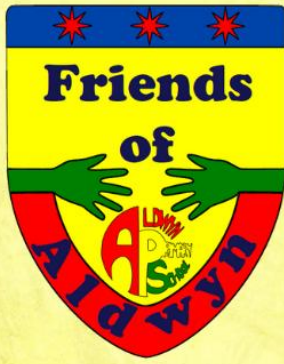
