The children are settling in beautifully and are enjoying their first half term in Year One. The children look lovely and smart in their new school uniform and new school shoes. Please can you check that you child's uniform has their name written in them especially their jumpers and cardigans.

Our School Values

Achieve Care Value Listen Help

This half term we will be looking at our 'Achieve' and 'Listen' school values. We will be reading the Little People, Big Dreams book about Usain Bolt. We will learn about Usain's life, his talent and about his determination to achieve. We will look at our talents and what we would like to achieve in Year One.

What will we read this half term?



Our topic theme for this half term is called Me, Myself and I. Our topic changes each half term in Year 1. We will start the term by sharing the book 'Dragons Don't Share' and 'Our Class is a Family'. We will then share the story of The Colour Monster. We will share these stories to help the children to develop a love of reading and we will use these stories as a stimulus for our sentence writing and stories.

What will we learn this half term?

Please note that all of the Curriculum Overviews for each subject can be found on the school website. These contain detailed outlines of the coverage and rationales for teaching. Please take time to read them.

English

In English we are using the following books: 'Dragons Don't Share' and 'Our Class is a Family'. In this term we will read 'Super Duper You' and we will be celebrating our own uniqueness! We will then share the story 'Our Class is a Family' and will be learning about our own families, what makes us special, and about our Aldwyn school family. The children will be learning about what a sentence is and using our Fred Talk to help us spell words. We will finally share the story of 'The Colour Monster' where we will learn about our feelings. We will also be writing our own stories called, The Colour Monster comes to Aldwyn. The children will continue with their Read, Write Inc phonics and will have a daily phonic lesson each day.



Maths

This term in maths the children will be learning:

- to count forwards, backwards and count objects from a group
- to sort objects by colour, size and type
- order and compare numbers using language such as greater than, less than and equal to
- addition and subtraction



There will be daily opportunities to solve problems in maths lessons and most importantly through play. Our maths area will support problem solving and give the children a chance to practice their new learning independently using familiar resources.

Science

We will be learning about the Human Body and our five senses. We will be carrying out some fun experiments exploring our senses. We will be learning about the different parts of our bodies and use the scientific vocabulary: **sight, hear, touch, smell and taste.**



Research Topic

This half term we will be studying Geography and being geographers.

We will be learning about what our local area is like and what our homes are like. We will learn about maps and what an aerial view is. We will look at maps of our local area and landmarks. We will learn the Geography vocabulary: **town, village, city, urban, rural, aerial view** and **map.**



Phonics

The children will continue to learn Read, Write Inc Phonics building on and consolidating their work in Reception. The children will have a daily phonic lesson where they will learn the Set Two and Set Three sounds. The children will continue to learn 'Fred Talk' and will use this strategy to help them sound out to read words and also spell them.



Art

We will be learning to 'Make Your Mark'. In this topic we will be exploring line and different medias to create collaborative pieces of artwork.



PSHE, SRE

In PSHE our topic is called Being Me In My World! We will learn about our place in the community and how to respect others using our Jigsaw PHSE Curriculum.



Music

We are looking at the topic Hey You! We will learn about the style of music called Hip Hop. We will listen to the differences in pulse, rhythm and pitch and learn how to rap and enjoy it in its original form.



PE

Our topic this half term is team building games and building on our gymnastics skills from reception. The children will have their PE lessons with our PE Coach, on Tuesdays and Fridays. Please ensure your child's PE kit is sent into school if it hasn't already been sent in. The children's PE kits will remain in school and will be sent home for washing at the end of this half term. If you need them before then, please let us know and we will send it home.



RE

We will be learning about 'Who do Christians say made the World?' through Bible stories in the Christian faith. We will celebrate different religions and festivals.



Homework

The children will have reading homework each night. The children are to practise their Home Reading Book every night for five minutes. The children have been given a Reading Folder with their Home Reading Book, a Reading Record and a Read, Write Inc sound mat. Also, the children will get a Homework Book with a weekly handwriting task given out on Fridays.
