Year 5 Get Creative with Halloween-Themed Digital Designs

Year 5 have been showcasing their creativity and digital skills by designing Halloween posters and videos using Canva, a powerful online graphic design tool. Pupils explored a variety of design elements, from spooky colour schemes to eerie fonts, and even used AI features to transform themselves into vampires and zombies! They enhanced their work with animated Halloween graphics and created short promotional videos that looked like trailers for new series on Netflix or Amazon Prime. Through this project, students developed essential digital skills such as layout design, image editing, animation, and media production. Using Canva allowed them to access a wide range of professional design tools in a user-friendly, online platform—helping them turn their imaginative ideas into eye-catching visual content with ease.
