



Developing children to become confident speakers is a partnership between school and home. You can support your child in developing their speaking and listening skills at home.

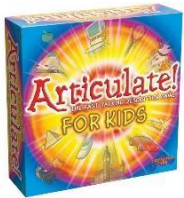
Here is a menu of Oracy activities for you to try.

Hed Banz



The aim of the game is to ask your opponent's questions to guess which object, food or animal you are.
