Last Friday, the Aldwyn Choir attended the Stockport Plaza to perform in this summer's Victorious Voices event alongside other schools from our trust. This year marked the first time that Victorious Voices was held at the Plaza and we were delighted to welcome families to join us in the audience.

The children represented our school wonderfully and sang with confidence and enthusiasm. We are extremely proud of their hard work and outstanding performance.



This week in PE, both 4M and 4C enjoyed continuing their cricket unit. The children focused on developing their bowling technique, learning how to hold the ball correctly, aim at a target and bowl with control and accuracy. They also practised key fielding skills, including stopping, collecting and returning the ball safely to a teammate. Pupils showed excellent determination and teamwork as they learned these new skills, building confidence and improving their understanding of the basic rules and techniques of cricket.



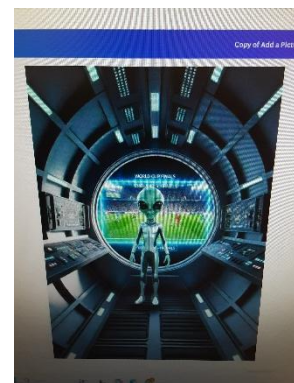
This week in Computing, Year 2 worked with Mr Goodier, our Computer Technician. We explored how Artificial Intelligence (AI) can be used creatively to transform photographs using Canva's AI tools.

At the start of the week, we used AI to turn ourselves into Ancient Egyptians. We created detailed prompts and descriptions to generate realistic costumes, hairstyles, and backgrounds inspired by Ancient Egypt. The children were fascinated to see how the AI could transform our images based on the instructions we provided.

Later in the week, we built on our new skills by creating even more imaginative images. This time, we transformed ourselves into astronauts and aliens, complete with exciting outer space backgrounds. We had great fun experimenting with different ideas and seeing our creations come to life.

We learned that being precise and detailed with our descriptions is very important when using AI tools. We discovered that the more information we gave the AI, the more accurately it could create the image we wanted. We also learned that we could continue to edit and improve our pictures by adding extra details to our prompts.

We even had an alien who was watching the World Cup Final! England beat Brazil 5-0. We are not sure if the future will look exactly like that, but we certainly hope it does!

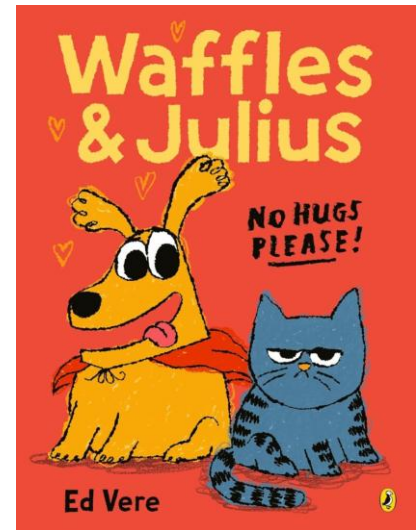
