To practise our measuring skills, we carefully used a centimetre ruler to measure strips of paper to specific lengths.

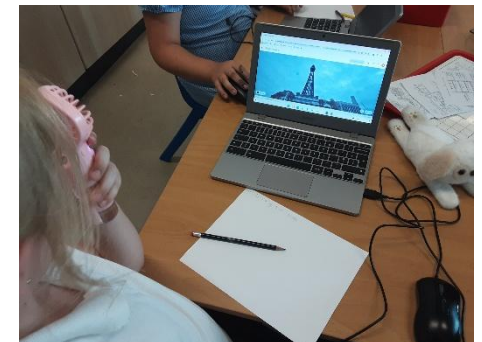
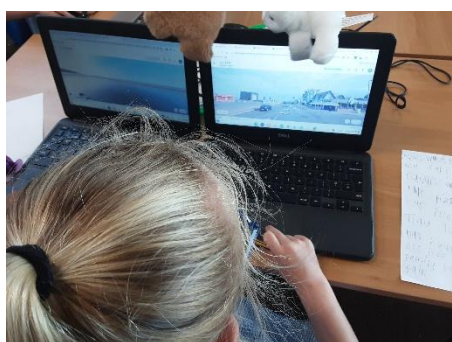
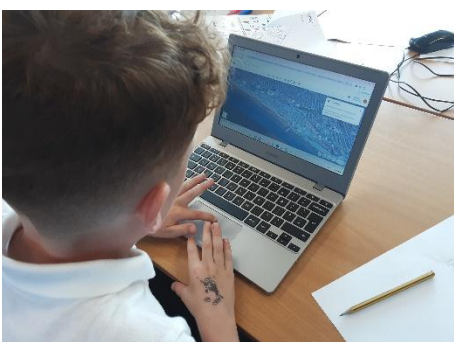
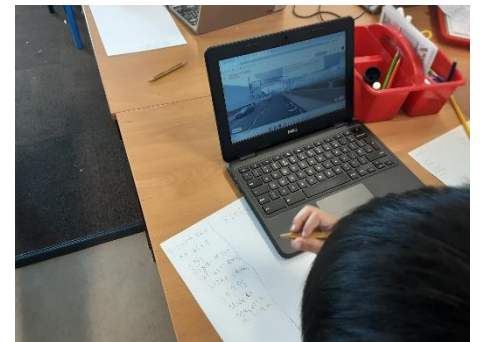
We then used the strips to design and make our own colourful decorations.



This term in Geography, Year 2 have been learning about what it is like to live by the coast. We have been exploring the human and physical features of a coastal town.

This week, the children used the Chromebooks and Google Earth to investigate the human and physical features of Blackpool. They explored both the 2D map and the 3D Street View, which allowed them to 'walk' along the streets and take a closer look at the seaside town.

The children enjoyed spotting different landmarks and many were excited to recognise places they had visited with their families. It was a fantastic way to bring our Geography learning to life!



Year 4 have been taking their photo editing skills to the next level and discovering just how amazing Artificial Intelligence can be!

Over the past few weeks, the children have been learning how to edit and enhance photographs using traditional photo-editing software. Once they had mastered the basics, it was time to explore the incredible world of AI-powered image editing and they were amazed by what it could do.

Our first challenge was to remove unwanted objects from photographs. In the past, this could have taken a long time and required lots of careful editing. However, with the help of AI, the children simply painted over the object they wanted to remove and watched as the software worked its magic! The AI cleverly filled in the missing area, often making it look as though the object had never been there at all. The children captured before-and-after screenshots and added them to their digital portfolios to showcase their impressive results.

Next came an even more spectacular task - transforming the sky! The AI automatically identified the sky in each photograph and allowed us to replace it with something completely different. From breath-taking star-filled night skies and dramatic lightning storms to stunning sunsets, the possibilities seemed endless. Of course, once we realised just how powerful the technology was, we couldn't resist having a little fun! Before long, ordinary skies were being replaced with giant animals, delicious food, colourful patterns and even photographs of the children themselves.



Families were treated to a musical spectacular on Wednesday after school when the children who have been having guitar and ukulele tuition with Front Row music put on a wonderful showcase of their learning.





Key Stage 2 enjoyed their sports day on Tuesday with the children getting stuck in to a range of different sporting activities.
